Fifth Sunday of Easter
John 13:31-33a,34-35

Jesus gives his disciples a new commandment: love one another.

Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel again comes from the Gospel of John. Like last week, today we hear words spoken by Jesus before his death and Resurrection. Jesus is teaching at the Last Supper.

John's Gospel does not include an institution of the Eucharist narrative; instead, Jesus washes his disciples' feet. Immediately after, Jesus predicts his betrayal by Judas. Today's Gospel follows that prediction. It can be read as a continuing explanation of Jesus' act of washing his disciples' feet. It begins with the announcement that this is the moment when the Son of Man will be glorified. This theme continues throughout John's Passion. Jesus will be glorified in his death on the cross and in his Resurrection, and the disciples will glorify Jesus in the love they show.

John's Gospel does not present a sentimental view of love. This is a type of love that is shown in service and sacrifice. It is difficult to choose to love when faced with hatred and anger. Jesus tells the disciples that all will know that they are his disciples because of the love they show for one another. This description of the early Christian community will be repeated in the Acts of the Apostles: "See how they love one another." Christian love is the hallmark of Christianity. We see it lived in the witness of the martyrs. We see it in the example of the lives of the saints. We see it in the holy women and men who live and love daily, making small and large sacrifices for others.

**Quinto domingo de pascua
Juan 13:31-33a,34-35**

Jesús da a sus discípulos un mandamiento nuevo: amarse los unos a los otros.

Antecedentes de la lectura del Evangelio

El Evangelio de hoy viene de nuevo del Evangelio de Juan. Como la semana pasada, hoy escuchamos palabras pronunciadas por Jesús antes de su muerte y resurrección. Jesús está enseñando en la Última Cena.

El Evangelio de Juan no incluye una institución de la narrativa de la Eucaristía; en cambio, Jesús lava los pies de sus discípulos. Inmediatamente después, Jesús predice su traición por parte de Judas. El Evangelio de hoy sigue esa predicción. Puede leerse como una explicación continua del acto de Jesús de lavar los pies de sus discípulos. Comienza con el anuncio de que este es el momento en que el Hijo del Hombre será glorificado. Este tema continúa a lo largo de la Pasión de Juan. Jesús será glorificado en su muerte en la cruz y en su Resurrección, y los discípulos glorificarán a Jesús en el amor que muestran.

El Evangelio de Juan no presenta una visión sentimental del amor. Este es un tipo de amor que se muestra en el servicio y el sacrificio. Es difícil elegir amar frente al odio y la ira. Jesús les dice a los discípulos que todos sabrán que son sus discípulos por el amor que se tienen unos a otros. Esta descripción de la comunidad cristiana primitiva se repetirá en los Hechos de los Apóstoles: "Mirad cómo se aman". El amor cristiano es el sello distintivo del cristianismo. Lo vemos vivido en el testimonio de los mártires. Lo vemos en el ejemplo de la vida de los santos. Lo vemos en las mujeres y hombres santos que viven y aman diariamente, haciendo pequeños y grandes sacrificios por los demás.

Saint Isidore (the Farmer)
Feast day May 15



Isidore was born in Madrid, Spain, and farming was to be his labor, working for the same landowner his whole life. While he walked the fields, plowing, planting, and harvesting, he also prayed. As a hard-working man, Isidore had three great loves: God, his family, and the soil. He and his wife Maria, who is also honored as a saint, proved to all their neighbors that poverty, hard work, and sorrow (their only child

died as little boy) cannot destroy human happiness if we accept them with faith and in union with Christ. Isidore understood clearly that, without soil, the human race cannot exist too long. The insight may explain why he always had such a reverent attitude toward his work as a farmer.

Isidore and Maria were known for their love of the poor. Often they brought food to poor, hungry persons and prayed with them. During his lifetime, Isidore had the gift of miracles. If he was late for work because he went to Mass, an angel was seen plowing for him. More than once he fed hungry people with food that seemed to multiply miraculously. He died after a peaceful life of hard labor and charity.

Isidore's goodness continued. In 1211, he helped the King of Castile in Spain during a war. He appeared to the king and showed him a path by which the king surprised and defeated the enemy. In the 1600s when Philip the King of Spain was near death, people processed to his room, carrying Isidore's incorrupt body. By the time they reached the room, the king had recovered.

Today Isidore is honored in Spain as one of the country's greatest saints, and he is also honored especially in the rural United States. Not surprisingly, he is the patron of farmers and of Madrid, the capital of Spain.
